Parent & Spectator Code of Conduct:

To safeguard the principles of sportsmanship, fair play and mutual respect among players, coaches, officials, and spectators. Play Together MN has established the following Code of Conduct:

1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and officials at every game.
2. I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of the athletes ahead of my personal desire to win.
3. I will not post any demeaning or abusive comments about players, coaches, and officials on social media.
4. I will remember that the game is for the young athletes - not the adults.
5. I will do my best to make sure that youth sports are a FUN and POSITIVE experience.
6. I will treat other players, coaches, fans, volunteers, and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability.
7. I will not berate the officials!
8. I will not undermine the coaches' instructions or directions.
9. I will not use profanity!
10. I will communicate my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.

Any Violation of the Code of Conduct may lead to being asked to leave the playing field. Multiple instances of poor behavior may lead to temporary or permanent banishment from youth sporting events.
