HOW TO BECOME A VOLLEYBALL OFFICIAL

1. REGISTRATION

*Referees looking to officiate sanctioned matches must be certified through USA Volleyball. Follow the steps below to get started!

Visit ncrusav.org/nc-official and select either the junior-aged official membership or adult certified official membership depending upon your age. Follow the prompts to complete registration through your SportsEngine account (this will include paying an annual fee to maintain your certification).

2. TRAINING

Complete all training requirements as directed by the membership process. This includes online modules and a certification test. All officials must complete SafeSport training (included with your membership). Adults must also complete a USAV-approved background screening as prompted during registration.

3. GEAR

Uniform accommodations are made for new officials, they will need the following equipment:

- Plain polo shirt (any color), dark pants, clean shoes (preferably neutral colors such as black or white)
- Whistle with lanyard
- Timing device (watch preferred)
- Yellow/Red card
- Flipping coin

4. WORKING

Register to officiate at USAV-sanctioned events by signing up for events through Advanced Event Systems (AES). Officials can sign into AES using their SportsEngine log-in and search for local events. 5. ASSIGNMENTS

Prepare for assignments. Communicate with your assignor that you are ready to work and follow their guidelines for demonstrating your availability and assignment preferences. Be sure to be aware of their payment processes.
